Shooting Range Rules and Standard Operating Procedures

Welcome – Shooter's Supply & Indoor Range would like to welcome all members, students and guest to our indoor shooting range, please shoot safely and enjoy your visit. We appreciate your business!

Access – No one may enter the range without having read the range rules, received a brief safety orientation, obtained proper safety gear, provided I.D. and signed our release and waiver agreement.

Hours – The range is open from 10:00 AM until 6:00 PM Monday through Saturday. Please wrap up your session, clean up and wash up to remove any lead residue from your skin so that you might be able to leave the building by closing time. We recommend that you change shirts when you get home.

Basic Safety Rules –

- **Always Keep the Gun Pointed in a Safe Direction.**
- **Always Keep Your Finger Off the Trigger Until Ready to Shoot.**
- **Always Keep the Gun Unloaded Until Ready to Shoot.**
- **TREAT EVERY GUN AS IF IT WAS A LOADED GUN!**

Remember – Know your target and what is beyond; make sure the down range area is unoccupied. Be sure the gun is safe to operate. Be familiar with how the gun operates. Use only the correct ammunition. Wear appropriate ear and eye protection. Never use alcohol or drugs before or while shooting. Guns should not be accessible to unauthorized persons. Please limit visits to one hour.

Stowage – All guns must be unloaded and cased prior to entering or leaving the property. Do not load the gun until you are on the firing line. Firearms should be unloaded at all times except when on the firing line. Never leave your firearm or range gear unattended.

Ages Requirements– Rifle shooters must be at least 18 years of age and pistol shooters must be at least 21 years of age to apply for membership. Youth accompanied by a parent or legal guardian must be at least 10 years old to shoot a long-gun and 12 years old to shoot a handgun. The parent or legal guardian is responsible for and must act as a coach/mentor and must stay with the minor at all times.

Cease Fire – Anyone can call a cease fire! If you have a problem with your gun or if you see someone handling a firearm unsafely, call a **“CEASE FIRE”**, place your firearm on the tray and step back from the booth, ring the call button and a Range Safety Officer will respond to address the situation. Do not return to the firing line to resume until the **“All Clear”** is called.

Guns Allowed – Only handguns and long gun (carbines only) firing pistol calibers not greater than 45 caliber are allowed. Shotguns must use slugs only with no magnum shells. No rifle caliber long guns or automatic firearms are allowed. No 44 magnums allowed.

Ammunition - For safety and air quality considerations we ask that you buy range ammo from the gun shop or certify that your ammo is “range safe” prior to entering the range. We offer quality attractively priced range ammo. You may fire up to 20 rounds of your personal self defense ammo per visit. No caliber greater than .45 cal. is allowed on the range. No ammunition designed to penetrate metal, tracers, incendiary, steel jacketed, explosive rounds and absolutely no hand loaded rounds allowed. No .44 magnum or greater allowed. Please limit high pressure ammo.

Drawing – No drawing from the holster is allowed without prior consent from the Range Master.

Management – Management reserves the right to reject or refuse anyone access to the premises.

Parking – Please park on the North end of the building as much as possible to leave spaces available for the Gun Shop and TPS Uniforms. You may exit by going down the North side out to the stop light.

Dress Code – Eye and ear protection is required on the range at all times. No flip-flops or open footwear. No clothing or jewelry that might prevent the safe operation of a firearm or allow hot brass access to the skin is allowed. No food, drink or tobacco products allowed on premises at any time.

Shooting Booth – Only one shooter and one coach permitted per booth. People not shooting or coaching are not allowed in the range. Observers may watch from the gallery viewing area. Keep to your assigned lane, no cross lane shooting and never move across the firing line. Guns are assigned to specific lanes, if shooter's wish to fire someone else's firearm leave the gun at the assigned lane and move to the other lane. Shooters can change lanes, never the firearm. Sweep up your brass behind the firing line and deposit it the brass buckets, do not attempt to move forward of the firing line at any time.

Target Only – Always keep your firearm pointed downrange at the target. Uncontrolled shooting resulting in damage to equipment is prohibited. Violators may have range privileges revoked and will be held liable for damage. Shoot at your target only. Please do not shoot the target clips.

Loaded Firearm – Never pass a loaded firearm to another person. A firearm is considered loaded unless its action is open (slide back or cylinder out) and magazine removed. Switch lanes not firearms. Always unload your firearms prior to leaving the shooting booth.

Pregnancy – No pregnant women are allowed in the range area for the safety of the baby.

Release and Waiver Agreement – The undersigned asserts that they have read the range rules and standard operating procedures and agree to follow said rules as well as all instructions and commands given by the management and employees of Shooter's Supply and to abide by all safety and operational rules including safe firearm procedures and the use of proper hearing and eye protection. The undersigned acknowledges that there are risk and dangers involved anytime firearms are involved and that the use of firearms may expose them to the risk of bodily injury or death even when precautions are taken. The undersigned further acknowledges that Range Safety Offices may not be on duty and that he/she assures that they are capable of handling themselves in a manner that will not pose a risk to themselves or others.

Therefore in consideration of the use of Shooter's Supply's facilities, the undersigned, his or hers heirs, next of kin, executors and administrators, hereby hold Shooter's Supply, its management, employees, agents and insurers harmless from any and all actions, demands, rights or causes of whatever kind arising out of damage to property, bodily and personal injuries or even death resulting from the undersigned's voluntary use of these range facilities.

The undersigned hereby warrants that he/she is trained and instructed in the proper use of firearms and familiar with the operation and characteristics of the firearm they will be using as well as the proper and safe use of firearms in general. The lack of proper training or instruction shall in no way limit the scope of this Hold Harmless, Release and Waiver Agreement.

By signing this waiver, it is the intension of the undersigned to release, waive and indentify Shooter's Supply, LLC its management, employees, agents, subcontractors, and insurers from liability connected with the undersigned's use of the range and other Shooter's Supply's facilities. The undersigned acknowledges that he/she signed this waiver voluntarily and of his/her free will. If any part of the waiver is found to be unenforceable the remainder will shall remain enforce according to the laws and codes of the State of Tennessee.
